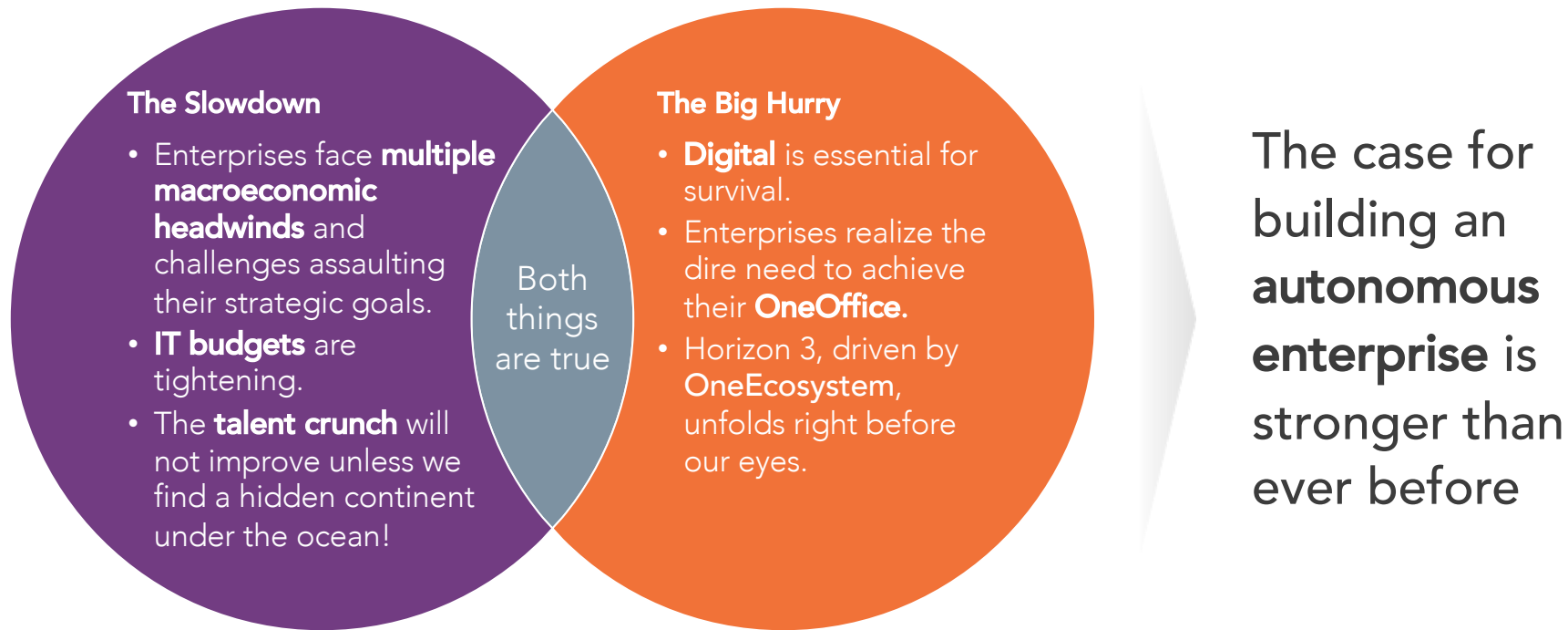

2023 represents the third phase of inflation-triggered enterprise innovation in the history of business operations

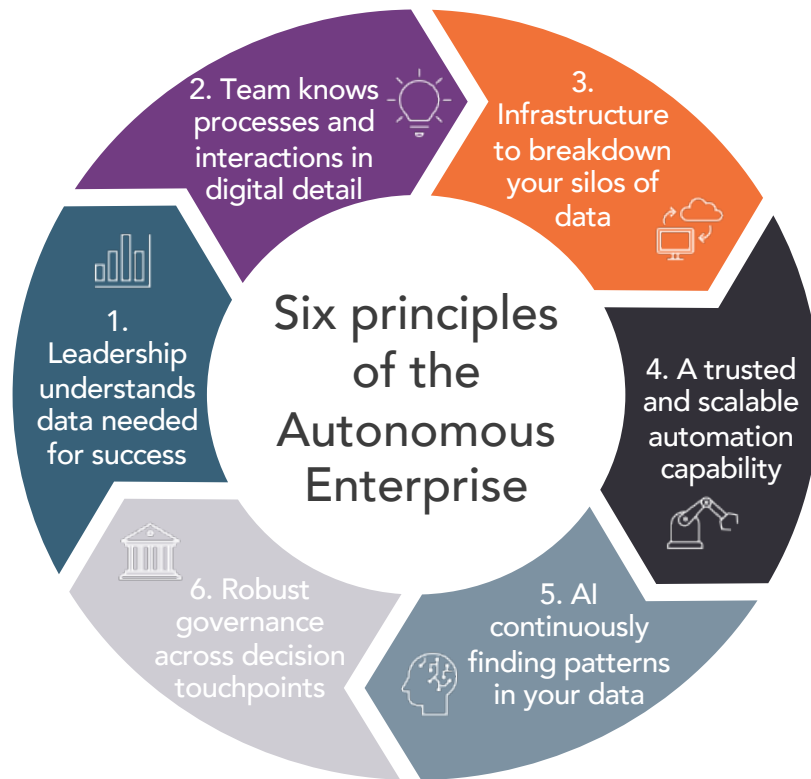


What's an autonomous enterprise?

Its goal is to allow us (humans) to remove ourselves from some parts of the system so we can make continuous improvements to the whole ecosystem

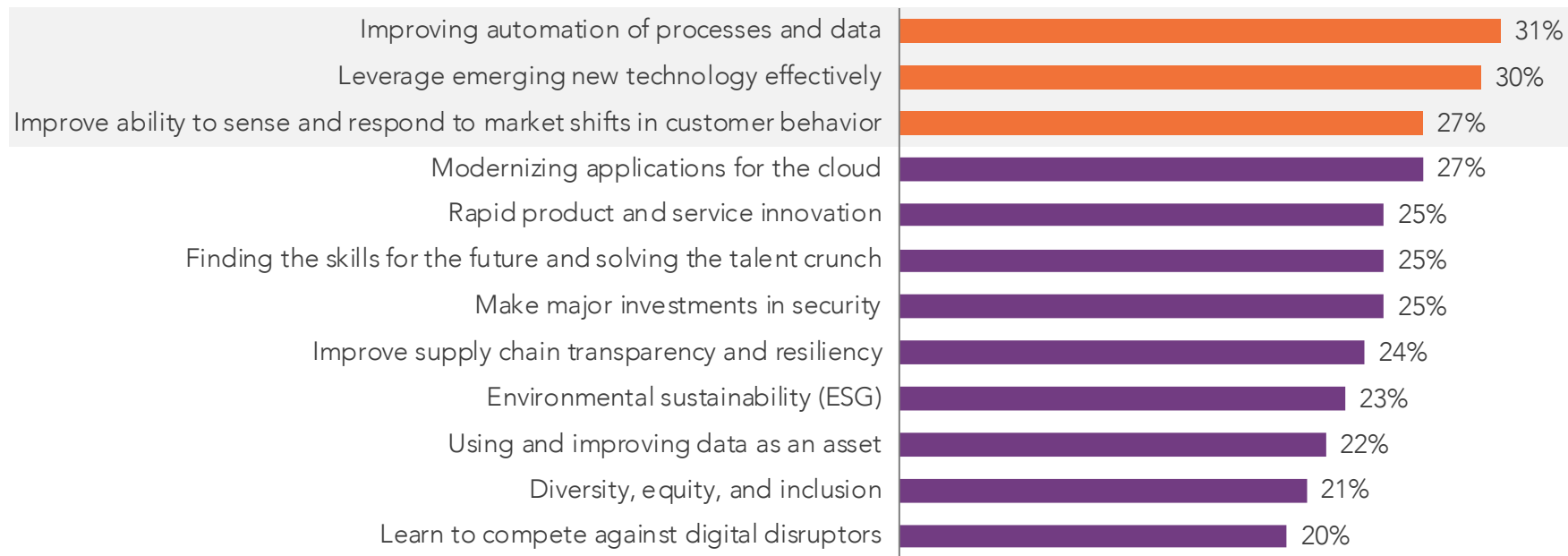
An autonomous enterprise is one whose leadership continuously seeks to refine the data it needs in real time to be successful.
